

PROGRAM OVERVIEW & IMPACT

Established in 2016, Safe2Tell Wyoming is a confidential statewide 24/7 reporting tip line that allows students, parents, and community members to share safety and wellness concerns. In it’s first decade, 11,856 unique Safe2Tell tips were processed, demonstrating its role as a valuable tool for early intervention and school safety.

TIP VOLUME & CATEGORIES

Nearly half of all system activity involved Health & Wellness concerns.

Health & Wellness	5,634	48%	Mental health, substance use, student welfare and safety, and public health
Safety Threats & Violence	2,686	23%	Violent behavior, threats and harassment, weapons and fire starting, and safety threats.
School Conduct & Climate	2,188	18%	Bullying, dating concerns, discrimination, student misconduct, and gang activity.
Admin & Policy Issues	747	6%	"Other," administrative and system issues, and school policy.
Exploitation / Misconduct	484	4%	Sexual misconduct, and concerns about an adult or school personnel.
Non-Violent Criminal/Legal	117	1%	Property offenses.

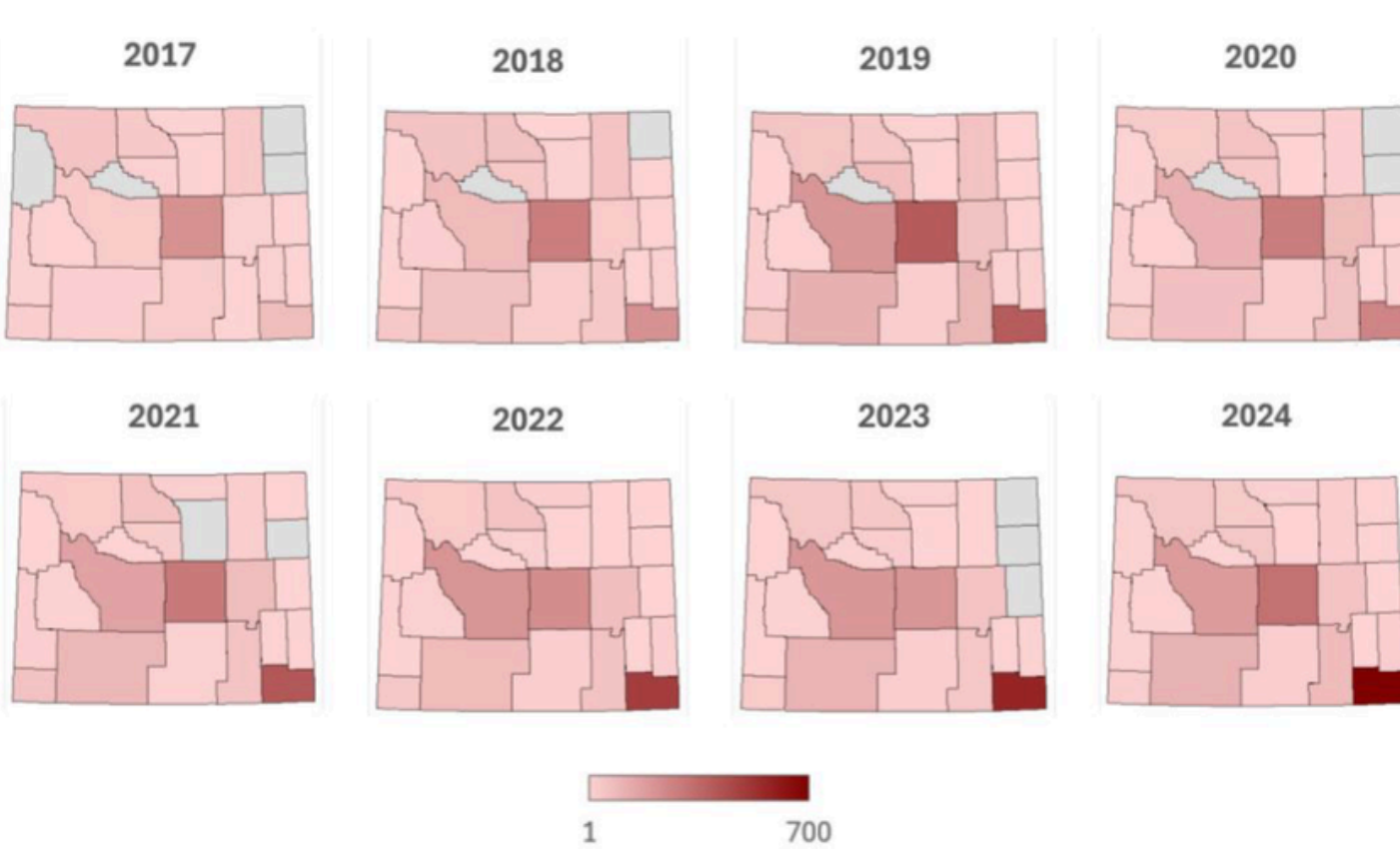
- **Drugs:** 50%

RESOLUTION PATHWAYS & OUTCOMES

Analysis of 10-year disposition data reveals that schools prioritize supportive engagement over punitive actions:

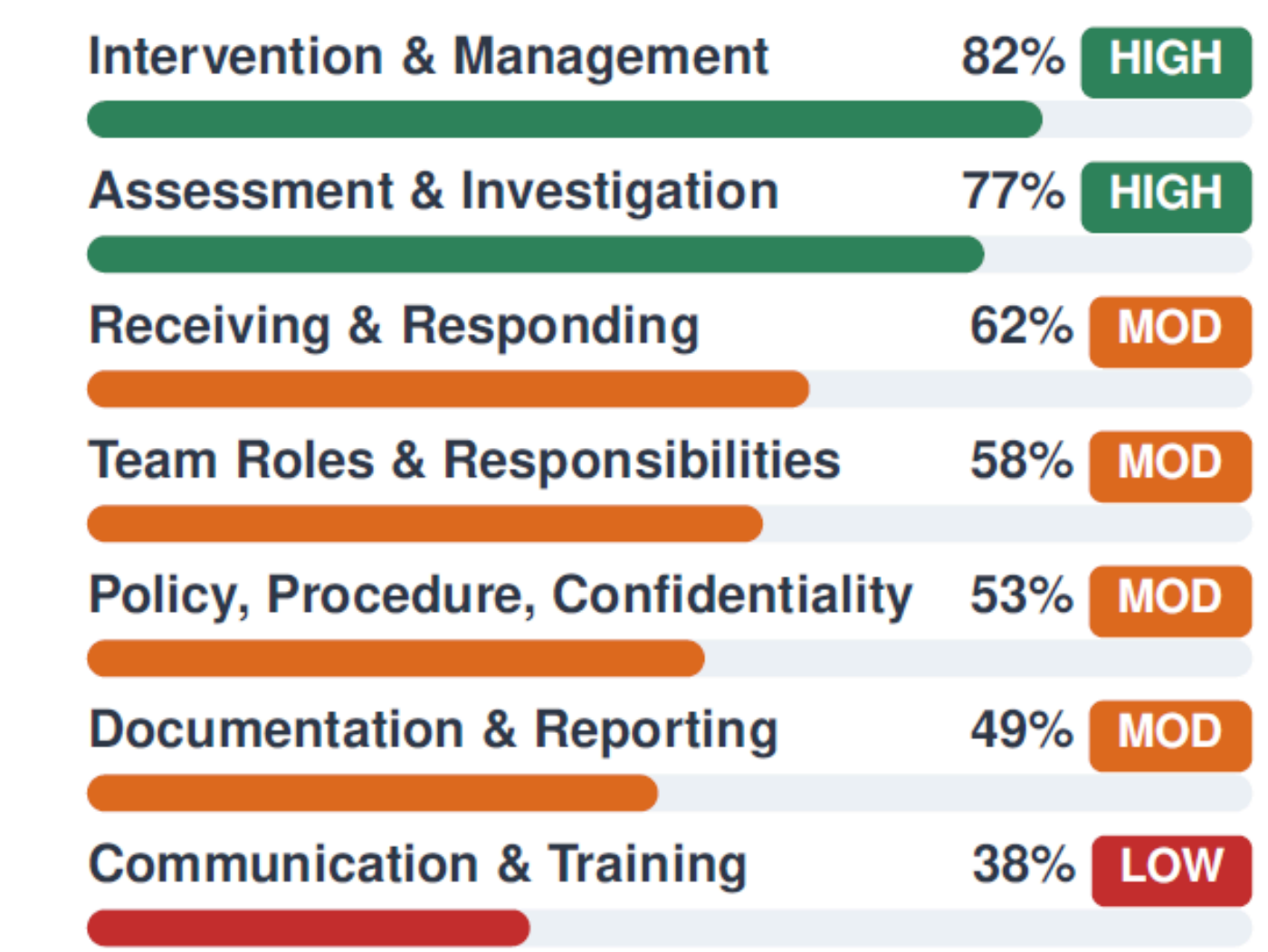
- **Family Engagement:** Parent/guardian notification is the single most common outcome overall (3,371 records), including 39% of all Health & Wellness concerns.
- **Structured Assessment:** Threat assessments were completed in 35% of all recorded dispositions, particularly utilized in School Conduct (76%) and Safety Threat (75%) contexts.
- **Mental Health Support:** 1,942 direct mental health interventions occurred, heavily favoring referrals to counseling (1,583) over medical holds (284) or emergency welfare checks (44).
- **Law Enforcement Response:** Documented in just 5% of all tips statewide, demonstrating that the most concerns are addressed through school and family mechanisms.

KEY CHALLENGES IDENTIFIED

- **Written Policies:** Only 19% of surveyed schools have formal written Safe2Tell standard operating procedures.
- **Data & Closing Gaps:** 26% of historical tips lacked a recorded closing disposition. 14% are explicitly marked "no disposition received."
- **Training Deficits:** The lowest scoring domain (38%). Nearly half report that team members receive no initial or ongoing training.

STRATEGIC PATH FORWARD

1. **Establish Model SOPs:** Standardize written workflows and triage definitions across schools.
2. **Mandate Onboarding & Refreshers:** Introduce flexible digital modules to counter staff turnover.
3. **Enforce Documentation Standards:** Standardize the use of the system's Disposition Tab to log outcomes accurately.
